

Visiting Corner Cottage

Arriving

If you are travelling light you can park your car and walk your luggage to the house. There is a good and reasonably secure car park at the top of the hill, St Saviour's, but you have to pay. It is signed as you come into the village. Alternatively, there is a less secure free car park at the top of the village just off the main road. It is also a longer walk to the house.

If you have more luggage and stuff you need to take your car down Fore Street and stop at the bottom of Chapel Lane, unload and leave things there and then move the car before returning to take your burdens up Chapel Lane to the house. Sometimes you can leave the car at the bottom of Fore Street without blocking it until ready to take it up to the car park.

House

Keys are in the key safe on the front door. I will give you the number, but please ensure you replace them when you leave.

If you need any linen or towels they can be found in a large black bag which is usually kept in the cupboard under the stairs, or failing that, there is a loft cupboard in the attic with a number of laundry bags in which you should be able to find anything you need in the way of bedding and towels. Please empty the black bag and put all your used laundry in it when you leave and I will ensure it is washed.

Behind the television you will find a socket you need to switch on to provide WiFi, TV, HiFi, etc. Connect to WiFi using SSID: CornerCottage and Password: CCPolruan. Please switch it off when you leave.

TV, Blu Ray player and Sky Q available. Unlimited broadband so you can use the on-line services if you wish.

Switch for the hot water labelled Off Peak is on the wall behind the cooker in the kitchen. If you need hot water instantly, the other switch is the immersion heater which takes about 30 mins to provide plenty. Please remember to switch it off.

The heated towel rail in the shower room is on a timer which will switch it on at night. However, if you wish to use it you need to turn the controller at the bottom to full. Again, please return it to the off position before leaving.

If you need to use the heating, please consult the manual.

There is a manual for the house which should give you a lot of relevant information. It is also available together with manuals for appliances etc on the web site www.cornercottage.org.

Help yourself to anything you need, but please replace anything you use. Please also report any problems to me. If you are a big party there is a large fridge in the basement if you need more space.

Please use the black bags provided in the bin in the kitchen and put them with all other rubbish in them in the dustbin outside marked CORNER COTTAGE. Also, recycling should be placed in the bags in the basement and put out on the requisite days. Details are on the notice board in the kitchen.
